

Study Options

For a successful exchange, you are required to ensure that the classes you wish to take at KTF fulfill the requirements of your degree programme at your current university. You should also check that you have the necessary pre-requisites to take the classes and that they are within the subject areas outlined within the student exchange agreement between Catholic Theological Faculty and your home university.

Please note that course availability changes annually and some courses are also subject to changes due to timetables and unforeseen circumstances.

Different types of study sessions

Teaching methods at KTF may also differ from your home institution. Please see below a general overview of the types of study sessions you will be expected to participate in whilst on exchange.

Lectures

Normally delivered by academic staff, lectures involve presenting to a large number of students. Students are expected to take their own notes during a lecture. Academic staff will direct students to use online learning resources connected to the topic of the lecture.

The lecture will often introduce you to a certain topic which might then be discussed in more detail in a seminar. Lectures require compulsory attendance.

In addition to the lecture, you will be given a list of books at the beginning of the semester and you are expected to complete the required and recommended reading on certain topics.

Self Study Options

Working in groups and self-study

In some cases students are required to work in groups on projects and assignments together. Self study involves independent working, you will need to spend time reading, researching, revising and making notes outside of lectures and seminars. Self study is an option for foreign students who cannot attend lectures and/or seminars taught in Czech language only. Our academic staff offer consultations in several languages. Detailed information can be found in the list of subjects.

If you haven't found the subject you need to attend on the list, you may ask the foreign relations department for cooperation. Most of the subjects taught in Czech are also available as a self-study option.

Please note that all courses are subject to timetabling considerations and there may be changes in course availability from year to year.

Important

You must take a **minimum 51%** of your subjects from the section **of your host faculty**. The **rest** (max. **49%** of subjects) can be selected **from the other faculties** of Charles University - if they correspond with your study field and there are places free in the course.
