- Current or former senior official of a Roman Catholic diocese responsible for its management and economy, at the same time a current or former senior official of the Czech Bishops' Conference, and at the same time a current or former charity executive.
- Teaching specialized in the theology of marriage and family. Teaching and/or publications dedicated to youth ministry.
- Creative activity in the field.
- Civic and moral integrity.

- Structured professional resume.
- Motivation letter.
- Overview of creative activities as well as other professional practice.
- Copies of educational documents (possibly with a Czech translation).
