


'DOXA'



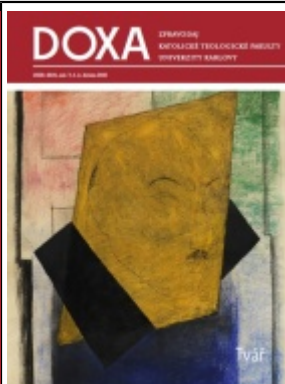
